

## Eastwind for Office 365 Setup Guide

### Overview

Eastwind for Office 365 allows organizations to monitor connections to their Office 365 Telemetry and feeds data to the Eastwind Breach Analytics Cloud. Eastwind for Office 365 requires a simple connection and API Authorization access to Office 365. This document outlines the following steps required to connect Eastwind and Office 365:

1. Logon to the Eastwind Portal to obtain information for the Office 365 API.
2. Logon to Office 365 to grant access to Eastwind for Office 365.
3. Logon to the Eastwind Portal to connect the applications.

Once you are connected to the Eastwind Portal, it will provide insights into data, such as:

- Office 365 Failed/Successful Logon Attempts
- Login IP metadata such as country and blacklist/whitelist designation
- Document Create/View/Update/Delete/Download operations
- API Authorization Failed/Success

### Before you get started note the following

Eastwind for Office 365 requires a pre-existing Admin account to connect to the Eastwind Breach Analytics Cloud.

You must have an Eastwind Networks account to access the Eastwind Portal. Click [here](#) if you have not already created an Eastwind Account.

### Link Eastwind for Office 365 to the Microsoft API

#### Obtain the Eastwind Networks API Account Information

To connect Eastwind for Office 365 and the Office 365 API, first logon to the Eastwind Portal using the provided credential to obtain API Integration details:

1. Logon to the Eastwind portal at [portal.eastwindnetworks.com](https://portal.eastwindnetworks.com).
2. Click on the Data Sources link in the left navigation panel.
3. Select the Office 365 link in the top options panel to access the Office 365 page.
4. Click on Authorize access to Office 365 Telemetry on the Office 365 page.

## Grant Eastwind for Office 365 Access to your Office 365 implementation

After clicking on the [Authorize access to Office 365 Telemetry](#) button, you will be directed to the Office 365 Admin portal.:

1. Logon to an admin account on the redirected page ([login.microsoftonline.com](https://login.microsoftonline.com)).
2. Read and [Accept](#) the EULA to grant Access.

After you click on the [Accept](#) button, the Eastwind will communicate with Microsoft to verify the connections and will redirect back to the Eastwind Portal. If the request was successful, you will see a green “Stop access to Office 365 data” button and banner confirming the transaction.

## Revoke API Access in the Office 365 Admin Portal

In the event that access needs to be revoked, use these steps:

1. Logon to an admin account at: [portal.office.com/account/](https://portal.office.com/account/)
2. Click on the App Permissions link.
3. Click on the Revoke link on the Eastwind Networks Office 365 app.

## Troubleshooting Issues when Connecting

If the Office 365 connection to the Eastwind Breach Analytics Cloud was unsuccessful you will see a warning banner showing at the top of the Eastwind Portal. Please either retry the steps or contact [Eastwind support](#).

## View Office 365 Data in the Eastwind Portal

Once connected, any communication to the Office 365 API on a monitored network will be logged in the Eastwind Breach Analytics Cloud and viewed in the Eastwind Portal. To view the data, logon to the Eastwind portal at [portal.eastwindnetworks.com](https://portal.eastwindnetworks.com) using the provided credentials and follow the steps below:

1. Click on the [Dashboard](#) link in the left navigation panel.
2. Click on the [Open](#) link in the top right-hand menu navigation.
3. Select the [Office 365 Telemetry](#) link in the [Featured Dashboards](#) menu.
